NOTICE TO APPLICANTS

RELATING TO THE PERSONAL DATA (PRIVACY) ORDINANCE

(THE "ORDINANCE")

- 1. Applicants for employment with the Firm are required to supply the Firm with data about themselves in connection with their application.
- 2. Failure of an applicant to supply such data will result in the Firm being unable to process his/her employment application.
- 3. If an application for employment is successful, data about employees may also be collected from employees during the period of their employment with the Firm.
- 4. Data relating to employees and potential employees may be used for the following purposes:
 - i. processing employment applications;
 - ii. reviewing remuneration and other benefits;
 - iii. consideration for training, internal posting, secondment and/or transfer;
 - iv. consideration of eligibility for staff loans; and
 - v. providing employee references.
- 5. Data held by the Firm relating to employment applicants and employees will be kept confidential but the Firm may provide and transfer such data to:
 - i. any other branch of the Firm whether local or overseas (e.g. China, Thailand and Vietnam);
 - ii. persons seeking employee references;
 - iii. any agent, contractor or other person who provides administrative, telecommunications, computer and other services to the Firm in connection with the operation of the Firm's business; and
 - iv. any other person under a duty of confidentiality to the Firm who has undertaken to keep such data confidential.
- 6. Under and in accordance with the terms of the Ordinance any individual:
 - i. has the right to check whether the Firm holds data relating to him/her and the right of access to such data;
 - ii. has the right to require the Firm to correct any data relating to him/her which is inaccurate:
 - iii. has the right to ascertain the Firm's policies and practices in relation to data and to be informed of the kind of personal data held by the Firm.
- 7. In accordance with the terms of the Ordinance, the Firm has the right to charge a reasonable fee for the processing of any data access request.
- 8. Requests for access to data or correction of data or for information regarding policies and practices and kinds of data held shall be addressed to:
