

# The "Deal"

If Parliament ratifies the Withdrawal Agreement negotiated with the European Union, the deal provides for a transition period for EEA and Swiss citizens. The UK government has indicated that these citizens' rights protections will be adopted in the UK domestic legislation within the EU Withdrawal Agreement Bill. During transition, EEA and Swiss citizens may apply for Settled status during an implementation period ending December 31, 2020. Free movement will continue during this transition period.
